

## How to Submit Public Comment for the February 9, 2022 AMBAG Board of Directors Meeting

On September 16, 2021, Governor Newsom signed AB 361 into law. The provisions enacted by AB 361 provide flexibility to meet remotely during a proclaimed emergency and will sunset on January 1, 2024. The AMBAG Board of Directors meeting will be conducted via GoToWebinar as established by Resolution 2022-2 adopted by the AMBAG Board of Directors at their January 12, 2022 meeting.
